almost a year taking care of her through her treatment. Because of my experience with cancer, and the experience of losing my grandmother, I became passionate about giving back to the cancer community in many ways.

The use of art and relationship as a way to aid healing touched me deeply and I knew I needed to be involved. I began volunteering, then I participated as an Inspiration and was matched with an artist. The experience was more rewarding than I imagined.
