

Artwork Shipping Guide for Artists

Thank you for being part of the Twist Out Cancer Community. We are honored to share your work and story. To ensure your artwork arrives safely and is ready for exhibition, please follow the guidelines below.

Shipping Timeline

- Artwork must **arrive no later than:** October 2, 2026
 - Please see the shipping address [below](#).
 - Late arrivals may not be guaranteed inclusion in the exhibition.

Artwork Requirements

- Artwork must be **fully dry and finished**
 - **Ready to hang** (unless otherwise approved)
 - Use **D-rings and/or wire** (no sawtooth hangers)
 - Please do not include glass inserts on framed artwork. This adds weight and potential for damage if the glass breaks in transit. Feel free to use plexi instead.
 - Clearly label the **back of the artwork** with:
 - Artist Name
 - Inspiration Name
 - Title of Piece
 - Contact Information

Size & Weight Guidelines

- Minimum size: 18in x 24in
- Maximum size: 3ft x 4ft
- If your piece exceeds these limits or is a sculpture or other piece that doesn't fit traditional measurements, please contact us in advance.

Packaging Instructions

Proper packaging is essential to protect your work:

Recommended Materials:

- Sturdy cardboard box or custom art shipping box
- Bubble wrap (multiple layers)
- Corner protectors
- Packing paper or foam inserts
- Strong packing tape

Packing Steps:

1. Wrap artwork in **glassine or plastic** (to protect surface)
2. Add **corner protectors**
3. Wrap securely in **bubble wrap**
4. Place in a **snug box** with no movement
5. Fill empty space with packing material
6. Seal thoroughly with packing tape

Tip: Shake the box gently—nothing should move.

Shipping Details

- Use a **trackable, insured shipping method (UPS, FedEx, DHL, etc.)**.
 - Insure your artwork for its **full value**

Important Notes

- Twist Out Cancer is not responsible for damage caused by improper packaging
 - We recommend documenting your piece with photos prior to shipping
 - If shipping internationally, please allow additional time and include customs documentation
